ORDER

Considering the foregoing Motion;

In recognizing that a piecemeal remediation effort providing for clean-up of the Class Area on a property-by-property basis is insufficient and an impediment to the recovery of St. Bernard Parish, creating islands of unpolluted land within a sea of contaminants, possibly resulting in the recontamination of remediated properties, and because the Court views the EPA-LDEQ-approved remediation plan as a step towards the recovery of the Class Area and the protection of human health and environment;

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Murphy Oil USA, Inc.'s Ex Parte Motion for Access to All Class Area Properties to Effectuate the Agency-Approved Closure Plan is **GRANTED**.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that allowing individual property owners to decline remediation services is potentially damaging to neighbors and is an impediment to the overall recovery of St. Bernard Parish.
