NOTICE

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Court, by separate order,¹ has approved the Parties' request to reschedule the Consent Decree Court Monitor Selection Committee's ("Committee") April 30, 2013 meeting to **Tuesday, May 14, 2013, at 12:00 p.m. noon.** The meeting will be held in the Bienville Club Lounge at the Mercedes-Benz Superdome, 1500 Poydras Street, New Orleans, Louisiana 70112. The Committee meeting has been rescheduled to **Tuesday, May 14, at 12:00 p.m. noon** because the Parties represented to the Court that they "are working diligently to attempt to reach agreement on a proposed monitoring team and are making progress."² In the event the Parties are unable to agree on a Monitor, the Parties are to inform the Court that they are unable to agree no later than **Tuesday, May 14, 2013, at 11:59 p.m.** The Court will then select the Monitor pursuant to paragraph 478 of the Consent Decree entered as a judgment of this Court on January 11, 2013.³
