**ORDER**

Considering the foregoing Motion of the Special Master:

**IT IS ORDERED** that any claimant, whose claim has had a determination on eligibility for payment under the terms and provisions of the Resolution Programs I and II, who objects to his/her records in the possession of the Special Master being destroyed, must file a written objection with the Court no later than Friday, April 15, 2011 and show cause on Wednesday, April 27, 2011 at 9:00 a.m. why such records should not be destroyed;
