

ORDER

The Court has received Plaintiff's Response to Recreation by Design, LLC's Motion in Limine Requesting that the Court Enter its Prior Rulings Made in the *Dubuclet* Bellwether Trial as to Certain Similar Evidentiary Issues (Rec.
