This case came on before the court upon
a motion for a special injunction & was argued
by counsel for the plaintiffs & defendants and
thereupon it is declared by the court that the
said plaintiffs are entitled to land, ^{or} keep, slaughter
any cattle, hives, calves, sheep, swine or other an-
imals and to have keep or establish any stock
landing yards pens slaughter houses or abattoirs
at any point or place on the East bank of
the Mississippi river within the parish of St Bernard
or in the corporate limits of the City of New Orleans
below the United States barracks or at any point
on the west Bank, ^{below the present depot} of the New Orleans Opelousas
& Great Western R.R. Company to the same extent
of right as the said Live stock landing
Crescent City Live stock landing have & enjoy
& that the said parties (plaintiffs) may carry
on the live stock landing & slaughter house
business and may prepare animal food
for markets & may receive and dispose of
the same and may keep & maintain
animals for sale & erect ~~stock~~ wherever they
desire & yards & do whatever it may be
lawful for the said defendants to do under
the terms of their act of incorporation
as an exclusive privilege - ^{subject to}
^{regulation as you would}

And the court directs that an injunction
be granted from this court enjoining
& restraining the defendants from commencing
or presenting any other suits upon their act
of incorporation than such as are now pending
in, against the said plaintiffs or either
of them, ^{for} doing or performing any
act, ~~in~~ ⁱⁿ ~~violation~~ embraced in the declara-
tory clause of this decree, or for suing
for any fine or penalty imposed in said
act of incorporation ~~in~~ ^{for} doing or
performing any of the acts referred to
or for interfering with them in the prose-
cution of their lawful occupations as
live stock dealers or butchers or as vendors
of animal food or animals.

And the said court here excepts from the
operation of this decree the proceedings in any
of the courts of the state that are now
pending, but reserves to the said plaintiff
all other remedies for their protection confer-
red in the Constitution of the United States
& act of Congress ~~for their protection~~
whenever ^{and} the lawful pursuits of said they
may be deprived of the rights then
claimed & ascertained.
