**AMENDMENT TO ORDER**  
**APPOINTING JOHN W. PERRY, JR. AS SPECIAL MASTER**

The Court’s Order of July 28, 2016 appointing John W. Perry, Jr., as Special Master (Rec. Doc. 21281) is hereby clarified and amended as follows:

The scope of the Special Master’s appointment shall not only include the consideration of an appropriate allocation and distribution of the Aggregate BP Common Benefit Cost and Fee Award,<sup>1</sup> but shall also extend to consideration of the appropriate allocation of the common benefit fees earned in connection with the States’ economic loss settlements,<sup>2</sup> and to any common benefit fees that may be awarded in connection with the Halliburton and Transocean Settlements.<sup>3</sup>
