respect to the Knauf class settlement agreement, except for those claims that we have identified on two lists.

Those lists are found at Record Doc 20517. It's Exhibit A and Exhibit B. Those are the remaining claims that we are aware of as far as ARH claims or remediation program claims that need to be either resolved, remediated, or, if there is some issue with it, needs to go to the Special Master and be mediated with Mr. Balhoff.

The motion is currently set for submission on November 9. We would ask that if anyone believes that their claim is not listed on those two lists, and they should be, to notify Knauf counsel prior to that submission date.

At the November 18 status conference, if the lists are all settled, and there are no objections, Knauf would move at that time for an order extinguishing its obligations with respect to the settlement agreement, except for those claims listed on Exhibit A and Exhibit B.
