## ORDER

## **IT IS ORDERED** that:

- (1) The Court will hold a status conference in chambers with liaison counsel and committee members on <a href="https://example.com/Thursday">Thursday</a>, <a href="https://example.com/August 7">August 7</a>, <a href="https://example.com/2014">2014</a>, at <a href="https://example.com/9:00 a.m.</a>. Counsel who are out of town may participate by telephone.
- (2) Not later than one full business day before the status conference, the PSC and counsel for James Kilbride and American Casualty Company of Reading,

Pennsylvania, shall submit a summary of the chief coverage issues in dispute<sup>1</sup>

and a proposed schedule for motion practice as to coverage issues.

(3) As soon as possible, but not later than the status conference, representatives

of the PSC and counsel for James Kilbride and American Casualty Company

of Reading, Pennsylvania, shall confer for the purpose of agreeing upon

date(s) in May or June for the commencement of a one-week jury trial on the

claims of the designated four bellwether plaintiffs. Upon reaching a

consensus as to workable dates, counsel shall inform the Court of such dates.

(4) Any motion for summary judgment by Franck's Pharmacy, Inc. and/or

Cincinnati Insurance Company on the issue of corporate veil piercing shall

be filed not later than **June 24, 2014**, with a submission date thereon of July

9, 2014.
