On January 26, 2021, the Louisiana State Supreme Court ordered that Attorney-Respondent Jaymeski Pullins-Gorham be suspended from the practice of law for a period of six (6) months, deferred in its entirety. The United States District Court for the Eastern District of Louisiana *en banc* considered the disciplinary matter and, by majority vote, determined that the court will impose a sanction of suspension from the practice of law in the Eastern District of Louisiana for a period of six (6) months, deferred in its entirety, subject to the completion of a one (1) year period of probation. IT IS ORDERED that Attorney-Respondent Jaymeski Pullins-Gorham, Louisiana Bar Roll Number 31746, is hereby suspended for a period of six (6) months, deferred in its entirety, subject to the completion of a one (1) year period of probation.
