

ORDER

On January 8, 2020, the Supreme Court of Louisiana issued a judgment of interim suspension entitled "In Re: James A. Dukes." At the direction of the Chief Judge, IT IS ORDERED that James A. Dukes be suspended from practice in this court. This suspension will become effective 35 days from the date of this order unless, prior to that date, Mr. Dukes submits a response showing cause why his right to practice before this court should not be suspended. If, after this suspension goes into effect, Mr. Dukes is reinstated as a member in good standing of the Louisiana Bar, he may apply to the clerk of court for authorization by the Chief Judge to resume practice as a member of the bar of this court.


