ORDER

On April 3, 2013, the Judges of this Court voted unanimously to consolidate the United States Probation Office and the U. S. Pretrial Services Office for the Eastern District of Louisiana. The office will now be known as the United States Probation Office for the Eastern District of Louisiana.


On July 10, 2013, the en banc court selected Kito J. Bess to serve as Chief of the consolidated office.

In accordance with the above, the consolidation of the Probation and Pretrial Services Offices is hereby made effective as of October 1, 2013. As of that date, Kito J. Bess is appointed as Chief United States Probation Officer for the Eastern District of Louisiana.
