PRETRIAL ORDER NO. 19

In Pretrial Order No. 18, the Court ordered the parties to meet and confer regarding a numerical limit on party and non-party depositions.¹ The Court further ordered that before a new limit is set, "no new depositions shall be noticed, but previously noticed depositions shall proceed."²

The Court now clarifies its ruling that any previously noticed depositions, including those that were cancelled as a result of the FTC's efforts to intervene in this matter, may be re-noticed and taken, and are not subject to the deposition limits to be imposed as set forth in Pretrial Order No. 18.
