**PRETRIAL ORDER NO. 21**

1. The Court is in receipt of the parties' most recent reports on the status of fact discovery.<sup>1</sup> According to those reports, the parties have completed document production and exchanged privilege logs. Accordingly, the Court will no longer require the submission of monthly discovery reports.

2. Henceforth, in advance of each status conference, the parties shall submit to the Court a report describing (a) the progress of discovery since the last status conference and (b) any issues or disputes that the parties want the Court to address.

3. If a discovery dispute arises that the parties jointly conclude requires the Court's attention before it would otherwise be addressed at a regularly scheduled status conference, liaison counsel may jointly submit a letter to Judge Vance and Magistrate
