DEFENDANTS' MOTION AND INCORPORATED MEMORANDUM FOR THE ENTRY OF A 54(B) FINAL JUDGMENT

NOW INTO COURT, through undersigned counsel, come Johnson & Johnson and Janssen Pharmaceutica Inc. ("Defendants"), and move this Court to direct the entry of a 54(b) final judgment as to all claims of plaintiffs who this Court has ordered dismissed with prejudice for their failure to submit Plaintiff Profile Forms to Defendants in violation of Pre-Trial Order No. 9.

BACKGROUND

Over the past year, at the monthly status conferences, Defendants have brought before this

Court several Motions to Dismiss with Prejudice against plaintiffs who have failed to submit PPFs to

Defendants in violation of Pre-Trial Order No. 9. At these conferences, Defendants moved to dismiss

This Court, after hearing oral argument from Defendants' Liaison Counsel, Plaintiffs' Liaison Counsel and at times from the respective plaintiffs' counsel, granted these Motions dismissing the claims of plaintiffs with prejudice.

At the October 25, 2001 and the January 11, 2002 conferences, Defendants' Liaison Counsel informed the Court and all other parties that Defendants would be seeking the entry of a Federal Rule of Civil Procedure 54(b) judgment regarding these dismissed claims. See, Transcript of Monthly Status Conference Hearings, January 11, 2002, p. 7 and October 25, 2001, p. 8. This Court acknowledged Defendants' intent to move this litigation forward, noting, "Yes, I do think we ought to move those cases, because as we move into the next phase of this litigation, we have to get rid of the cases that are not part of the process so that they don't resurrect, or somehow or another slow down the active participants in this litigation . . . "See, Transcript of November 30, 2001 Status Conference, p. 8.

Defendants contend such time is now, and there is no just reason for further delay.

Defendants attach to this memorandum a proposed Order in which Defendants suggest the following summary of reasons for the dismissal of prejudice of these plaintiffs:

- The plaintiffs made subject of the Motions to Dismiss with Prejudice identified on Appendix A, which is incorporated into and made part of this Order, violated Pre-Trial Order No. 9 by failing to furnish Defendants with a Patient Profile Form;
- 2) The plaintiffs made subject of the Motions to Dismiss with Prejudice identified on

Defendants attach to this Motion and Incorporated Memorandum a proposed Order with Appendix A, identifying all plaintiffs who are subject to the Order. Plaintiffs' Liaison Counsel has received and reviewed these documents.

Appendix A failed to respond to multiple written notices of their violations by

Defendants' Liaison Counsel and Plaintiffs' Liaison Counsel;

3) The Court's record reflects that the plaintiffs made subject of the Motions to Dismiss

with Prejudice identified on Appendix A were informed by the Court that their claims

would be subject to dismissal on proper proof; and

4) Despite such notice, the plaintiffs made subject of the Motions to Dismiss with

Prejudice identified on Appendix A failed to act in submitting Patient Profile Forms to

Defendants.

Based on the foregoing summary of reasons, Defendants respectfully request that this Court

designate the dismissal of each of these named plaintiffs as final under Federal Rule of Civil Procedure

54(b) and issue an Order so stating.

ORDER
